Surface preparation for High performance Coatings on Concrete

Properly applied concrete coatings provide excellent protection and extend the useful life of new and deteriorated concrete. A suitably prepared surface is essential for successful application and long-term durability of the high-performance coating systems. Coating applicators are frequently asked to fill in blanks in specifications and perform the work needed to meet this objective.

Mike Dadik, a structural engineer who specializes in water and wastewater construction, and Ray Tombaugh, a NACE certified inspector and coatings consultant, will discuss a wide range of topics that influence the quality and level of effort required to get concrete ready for coating.

Beginning with an understanding of concrete, new and degraded, along with an explanation of the various types of repair mortars, the presentation will discuss the work and tests recommended to prepare a surface for coating. Factors to consider when selecting the coating system will be discussed along with the common and not so common concrete and rebar repair methods.

With over 50 years combined experience the presenters bring two unique perspectives and a lot of common sense strategies that will help you understand what it takes to get concrete ready for coating.
